

Honors Program

Some students may qualify and choose to participate in the honors program. Below are the guidelines for the honors program for students in the College of Engineering on the Omaha campus. More information can be found at <http://www.unomaha.edu/~www/honor/>

ADMISSION CRITERIA

General: All unrestricted students entering or enrolling in the College of Engineering may be considered for membership to the College of Engineering Honors Program. All students who apply for membership in the College of Engineering Honors Program must meet the following requirements:

- Entering Freshmen: Top 10% of high school graduating class, or a composite ACT score of 26 or better.
- Transfer and current students: A cumulative overall GPA of 3.25 or above for at least 12 credit hours earned at UNO and a minimum of 3.50 GPA for all major curriculum courses taken at UNO

To maintain membership in the College of Engineering Honors Program, the student must maintain a minimum 3.25 overall cumulative GPA and minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA in the major curriculum courses.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Meet all program and college requirements for graduation
- Complete a minimum of 15 hours of designated Honors course work with a 3.50 GPA or above in all courses for which they receive Honors credit. Complete 15 of 18 hours of predetermined major curriculum core courses with a GPA of 4.00. Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 for all other UNO courses
- 15 hours Honors credit must be earned outside the student's major program area, which shall include at least one English, or Communication honors designated course
- At least 6 hours honors credit must be upper division (300 level and higher) courses, which may be the Honors Colloquia
- Complete at least 6 hours of Honors Colloquia
- The 18 hours of predetermined major curriculum core courses shall be contracted by the student and their assigned Honors advisor and the College Honors Coordinator
- Complete an Honors Thesis/Project as a separate credit course requirement. The Senior Project may be utilized for the Honors Thesis
- Generally try to complete at least 60 hours as a Honors Program member

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING HONORS DESIGNATED COURSES

All courses offered by the College of Engineering, UN Lincoln on the Omaha campus 300 level and higher are available for Honors Contract Credit to Honors students who meet the prerequisites.
