

## Humanities and Social Science Requirements (Omaha Campus)

### Humanities and Fine Arts Requirements (9 credit hours):

At least nine credits must be taken in the Humanities and Fine Arts. Courses must be chosen from the list of Humanities and Fine Arts courses that are approved by the Civil Engineering Department on the Omaha campus. A list of these courses is given on the next page.

### Social and Behavioral Science Requirement (9 credit hours):

At least nine credits must be taken in the Social and Behavioral Sciences. Courses must be chosen from the list of Social and Behavioral Sciences courses that are approved by the Civil Engineering Department on the Omaha campus. A list of these courses is given on the next page.

### Cultural Diversity Requirement (6 credit hours of the 18 total credit hours for Humanities and Social Science Requirements):

The cultural diversity requirement may be satisfied in whole or in part by course work taken to satisfy the Humanities and Social Science Requirements. Three cultural diversity credits must be in the area of US racial and minority groups. Three cultural diversity credits must be in the area of women's studies/international/foreign focus. Courses must be chosen from the list of Cultural Diversity courses that are approved by the Civil Engineering Department on the Omaha campus. These are listed on the following page. Humanities and Fine Arts and Social and Behavior Sciences courses that also fulfill the US Racial or Minority Studies requirement are shown in **bold** on the following page.
